EEACA - BUS DRIVER EXAMINATION AND TRAINING

The driver of a school bus is charged with a serious responsibility for the safety of the children in his/her care. It is therefore important that school buses only be operated by a properly licensed driver who has passed all examinations prescribed by the statute and the department of public safety. Such license will be issued annually to a driver who complies with all regulations.

In application for a bus driver's license and in accordance with state law, each bus driver will be required to have an annual physical examination. Licensing fees and the cost for physical examination will be reimbursed to the bus driver, provided that all requirements have been met for certification.

When services are provided through a contracted bus service, it is the responsibility of the company to maintain qualified drivers in accordance to state law.
